DCM

Four years of sobriety

Preside over monthly district four meetings.
Attend groups within the district to encourage
Communication and relay information. Attend
All Area 78 assemblies and Area committee
meetings(4 per year)

Alt DCM

Four years of sobriety

Assume duties of DCM if DCM is unable
to attend Area 78 meetings. Update GSO
and Area 78 group records of any changes
to the GSR body and district.

Treasurer

Two years sobriety

Maintain district bank account. Maintain
Literature bank account. Receive all funds
and perform deposits. Complete monthly
spreadsheet with expenses and income
for presentation at monthly meetings

Secretary

Two years sobriety

Take minutes of each district meeting.
Distribute minutes within two weeks
of meeting. Update group contacts
and GSR information as required.

Committee Chairs

Summary of positions

Two years of sobriety for committee chair positions

Public Information and Co-operation with the Professional Community

Distribute literature, brochures to community organizations. Make AA presentations to schools,
police and other
organizations. Prepare a yearly budget and presentations.

Archives

Maintains past minutes, reports and motions from the district. Gathers and maintains relevant
district 4 history items, past
literature, tapes, photos.

Literature

Maintain an inventory of current AA literature. Order through GSO as required or requested
literature from groups, including
books, group materials or related items.

Remote Communities

Encourage AA members to perform service work to help remote communities. Communicate
with the Area remote
communities chair for regional events and or opportunities for service.

Telephones

Maintain a volunteer list for the district four AA phone number. Respond and distribute calls to
the district four phone line for people looking for assistance or twelve step calls.

Treatment and Accessibilities

Co-ordinate speaker meetings on Thursdays and a chair for meetings at the N.A.C. Serve as a
liaison between treatment facilities and A.A.
